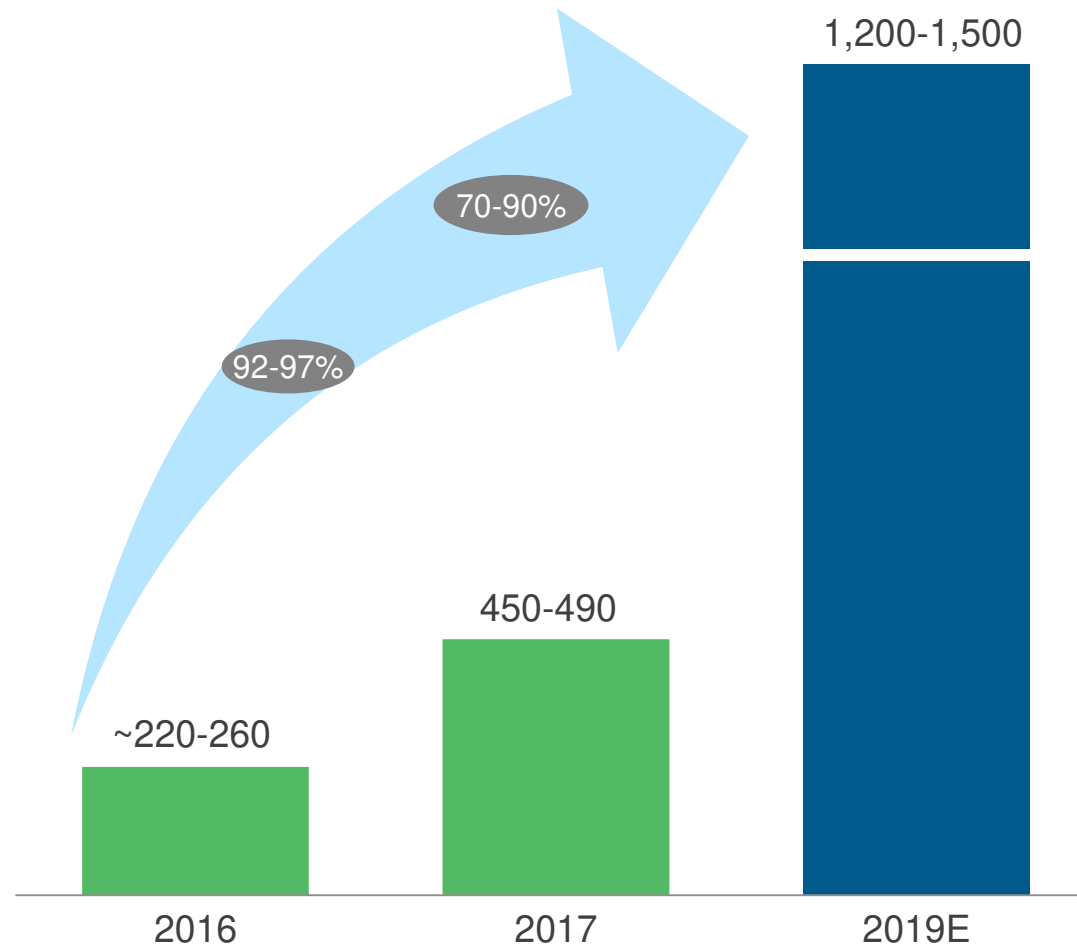

What do the latest developments in RPA technology mean to enterprises?

- Scheduled or event-driven
- Rules based
- Human exception handling
- UI interface based on objects on screen
- Command line interface with robots
- Failed robots stop working
- Standardized function-specific or vertical processes have to be coded from scratch
- Mostly standalone RPA products



- Scheduled, event & exceptions driven, workload balancing with process priority recognition managed by controller or orchestration engines
- Rules and machine learning
- AI & human exception handling
- UI interface aided by computer vision
- Text, voice, vision/virtual reality or gesture commands
- Failed robots will run self-diagnostics & self heal
- Function-specific or vertical libraries of pre-built automations & robot parts
- RPA platforms integrated with other solutions e.g. BPM & AI

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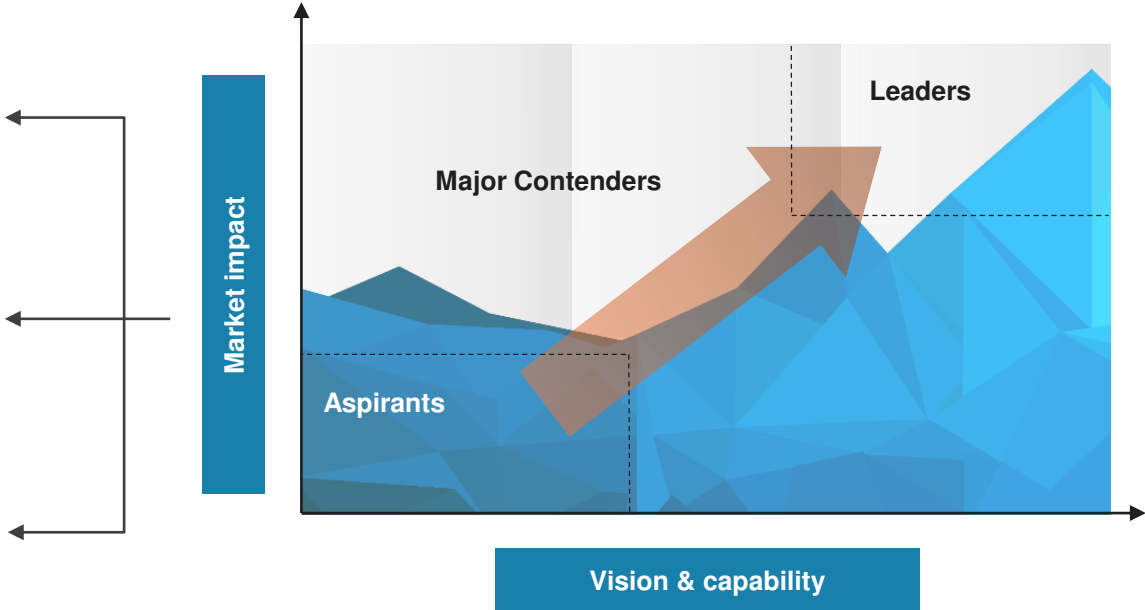

Value delivered to the client and their satisfaction with the product as well as support, based on client feedback and other measures



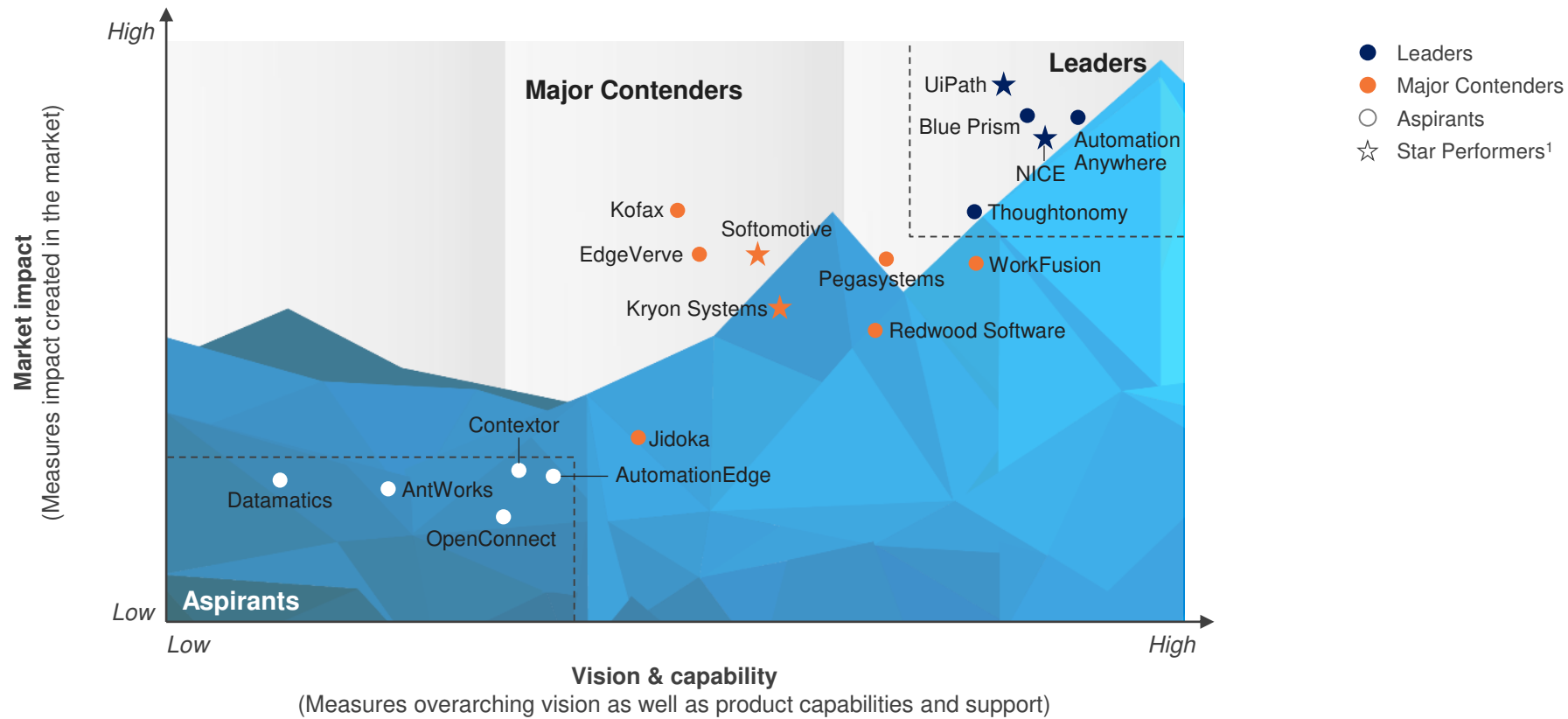

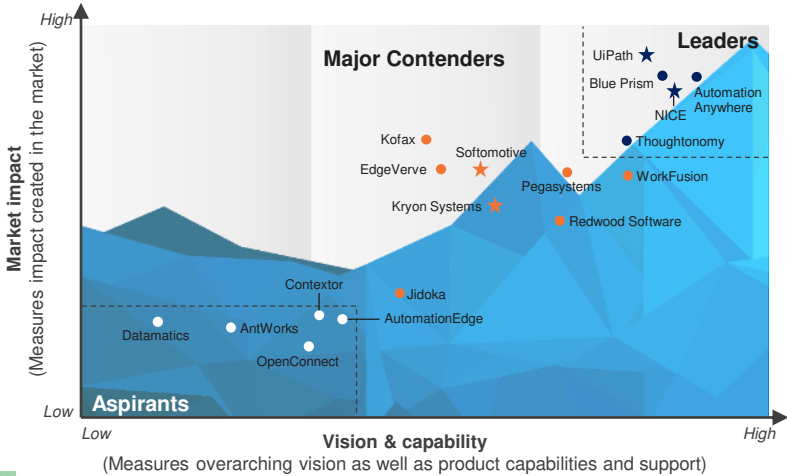

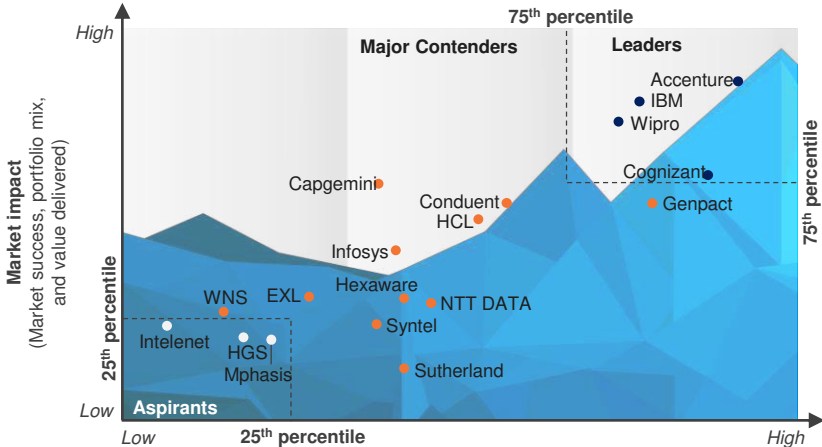
360 degree view of the market



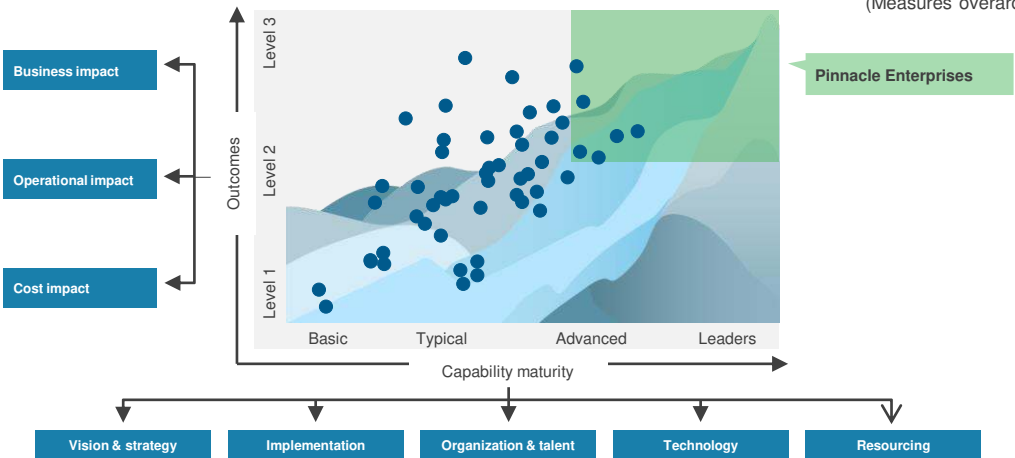

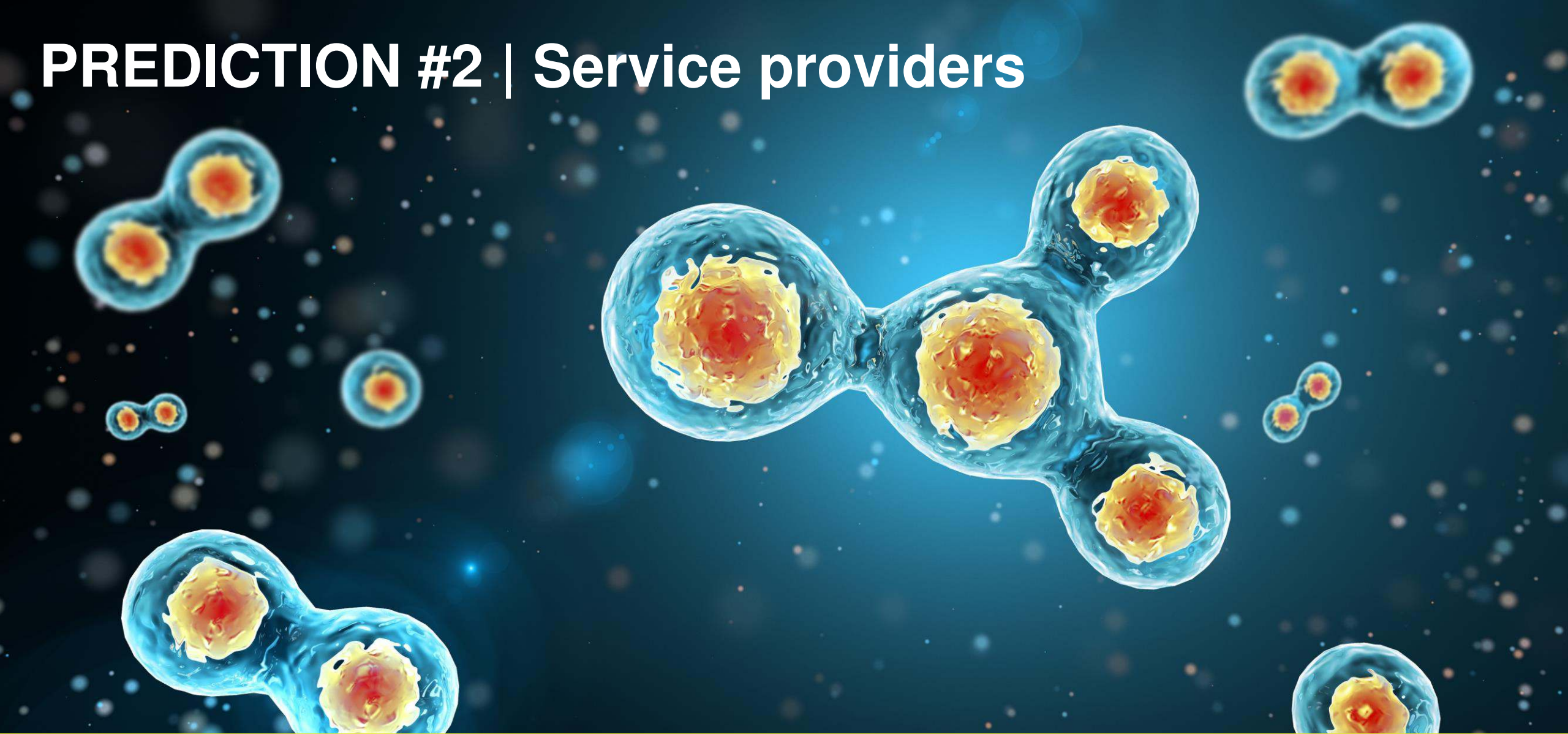

GICs need to take a **FORCEful** approach to drive digital pervasiveness

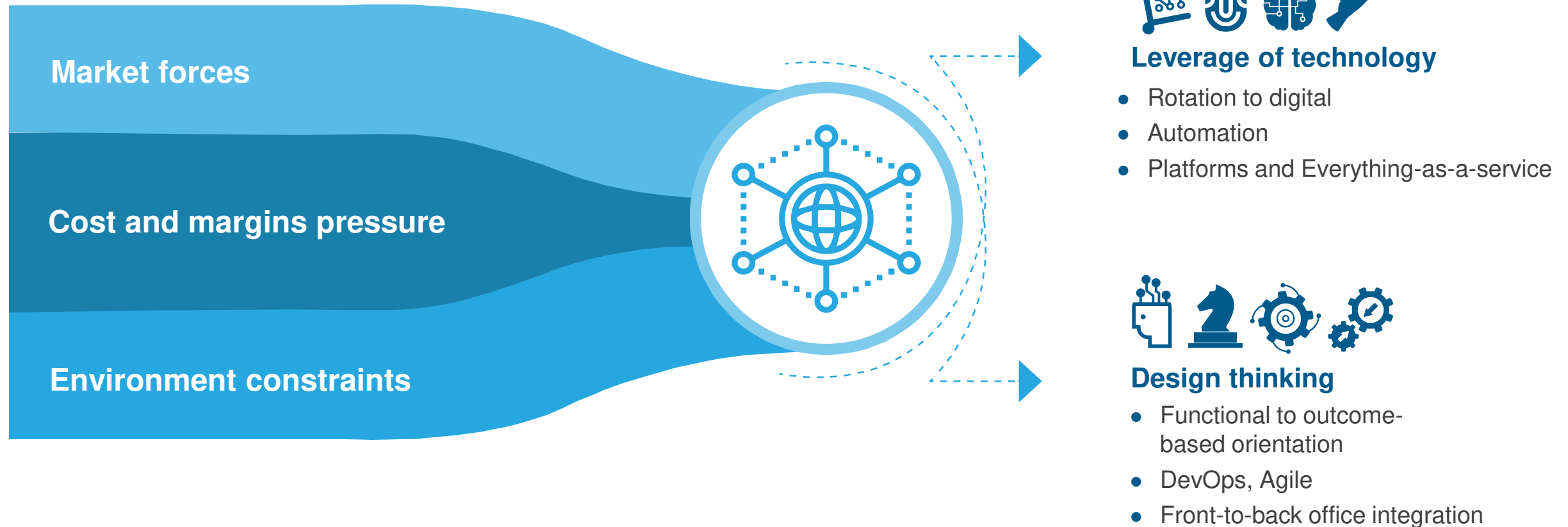
